European Tour winner David Lynn demonstrates
how to make the most of your three wood



WHEN faced with a quick downhill chip from dense greenside rough it is sometimes best to use a three wood. The shape of the clubhead will get the ball rolling, like a putt, as quickly as possible. Taking my putter grip I take the club back smoothly and gently accelerate, collecting the ball as I brush through the grass. The ball is likely to jump one or two yards and then roll out to a finish and, hopefully, a tap-in par.
