Two-time European Tour winner Richard Finch demonstrates how to attack the flop shot with confidence every time



WEAK AND OPEN

Too many amateurs are beaten before even attempting this kind of shot but there need not be any undue cause for concern if you get the fundamentals right.

Firstly weaken your left hand on the grip so you can barely see the second knuckle on the back of your hand and then open up your stance similar to a bunker shot



IN RICHARD'S BAG

Driver Nike SQ 5000 10.5°

Fairways Nike SQ2 15 & 19°

Irons Nike VR Blades 2-PW

Wedges Nike VR 53 & 60°

Ball Nike One Black 08



FINISH ON A HIGH

By having an open stance it will encourage you to make an out-to-in swing path. Talled with the weaker grip you should have plenty of loft going into the shot so take a longer swing than you might imagine and trust yourself. Commitment and confidence are the final ingredients so look to produce a full, rounded finish
